TONYPANDEMONIUM

Three years ago the idea of writing drama for the stage filled me with abject terror. How would I, writer of books, go about structuring an hour long play without resorting to hundred word descriptions of landscapes, weather? I didn't know the first thing about theatre writing. I had no idea. What I did, the only thing which seemed possible, was to write a few short scenes, in and of themselves, designed to be moved around if need be, the first things that came to my head.

Gradually a vague plot outline emerged, an account of a dysfunctional mother/daughter relationship. Some of the scenes were gut-wrenching, others comic. They spanned the whole length of the daughter's teenage years. Then more scenes, and more; they came quickly and in no order, like memories, a sort of regression. Maybe because, at its heart, the story is autobiographical; the relationship featured based loosely around my own fraught bond with my late alcoholic mother. The result is an anomaly, a mosaic, a patchwork sewn with fact, fiction, anger, love.

The Park & Dare Theatre in Treorchy has been a part of my life for as long as I can remember. For instance, I recall, aged twelve, borrowing my mother's hoop earrings, plastering my mouth with her orange lipstick, dousing myself in her Chanel No.5, all so that the lady on the ticket desk might let me in to see Pretty Woman, (certificate 15). The fact that my play will be staged, as part of the theatre's centenary celebrations, is especially poignant for me; poignant, stunning, still utterly terrifying.
